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PROTOCOL 010 - AIR LAW

Semantic Memory Load Management

Threat Analysis

Module 010 is an administrative endurance test. The danger is not intellectual complexity, but textual hypnosis. Linear reading of ICAO Annexes or EU regulations creates an illusion of reading: your eyes scan the text, but your brain encodes nothing. You turn the pages feeling as though you are working, when in fact you are not creating any usable memory traces.



The Intervention Protocol

01

Segmentation through Failure

Do not read the course first. Start directly with blocks of 20 questions. Failure on a specific question (e.g., "What is the vertical separation above FL410?") creates a cognitive "shock" that opens a window of maximum attention.

02

Flashcard Encoding

For each rule encountered, immediately create a flashcard. Front: The context (RVSM Separation). Back: The raw data (1000 ft). This active extraction transforms passive information into retrievable knowledge.

03

Competency Maintenance

This knowledge is highly volatile with a short half-life. Schedule this module exclusively for **Session 4**, a maximum of 4 weeks before the examination. Too early, and you will have forgotten everything by exam day.

⊗ **Fatal error to avoid:** Searching for Logic.

- *Why:* Trying to "understand" the course. There is nothing to understand; it is arbitrary. The error is not using brute force (Flashcards).

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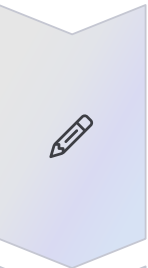
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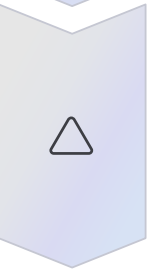

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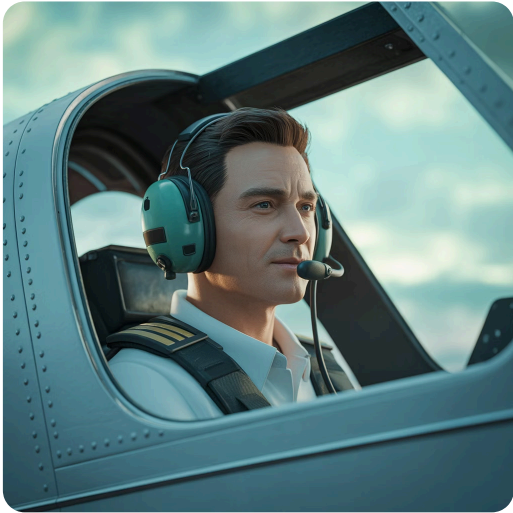
